A Hawaii real estate broker is licensed to engage in paid real estate activities including: selling, auctioning, exchanging, listing, purchasing, renting, and leasing real estate. The next step up from a salesperson, a broker manages the work of other real estate professionals.

A Day in the Life

A real estate broker is typically responsible for hiring, training, and managing the work of other real estate agents. In a management role, you will supervise the marketing and advertising of the company, as well as its listed properties. Depending on how much time you have, you may also sell and list real estate yourself.

Starting Out

After getting your Hawaii real estate broker license, you can launch your own brokerage, which may be independent or part of a national or local franchise (i.e. Coldwell Banker, Century 21, Prudential, and RE/MAX). Some real estate brokers choose to be managers for national or local real estate companies, instead of owning their own firm.

Unlimited Earning Potential

Just as when you started out, the sky's the limit when it comes to your earning potential. As a real estate broker, however, you get the added bonus of earning commission on other agent's sales.

HAWAII REAL ESTATE BROKER LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

To obtain a real estate broker license in Hawaii you need to:

1. Complete an 80-hour Hawaii real estate broker's course. The broker's license curriculum is offered in three separate courses called: (1) Real Estate Basics and Beyond, (2) Hawaii Real Estate Laws and Rules, and (3) Hawaii Real Estate Principal Broker. The courses include reading lessons, quizzes, several practice final exams. You must show evidence of having taken and passed all quizzes and exams with a score of at least 75% OR apply for and obtain a Prelicensing Education Equivalency from the Hawaii Real Estate Commission.
2. Obtain a Broker Experience Certificate. To gain entrance into the state licensing exam, you will need a Broker Experience Certificate. You obtain this from the Real Estate Board by showing them evidence you have been working full-time as a Hawaii real estate salesperson for three of the last five years.
3. Pass the broker's license examination. You must pass a 130-question multiple-choice exam. 80 of the 130 questions focus on national topics. 50 questions focus on Hawaii laws. A score of at least 70% is required for both the national and Hawaii-specific sections. Your passing score report will include an application form for your real estate broker license. You will be required to present a valid and original Hawaii School Completion Certificate or Prelicensing Education Equivalency Certificate at the assessment center before taking the examination.
4. Submit the license application and fee to the Hawaii Real Estate Commission.
